Online teaching pedagogy is to be understood and teachers should be well-trained in this area. University teachers are experts in their subject domain but have never been trained in the e-learning domain. University of Mumbai has been using MOODLE Learning Management System for the past 12 years, though restricted to IDOL initially but now being adapted by more departments. As the usage is definitely going to increase, a need for rigorous training on MOODLE is necessary now.

PREAMBLE

University of Mumbai has been using MOODLE Learning Management System for the past 12 years. Use of Moodle was restricted to IDOL initially but now is being adopted by many more departments. FORMAT OF THE BLENDED MODE FDP & WORKSHOP:


The participants will be enrolled in a blended mode FDP & Workshop course hosted on the University of Mumbai's Moodle LMS.


