Online applications are invited for admission to LL.M. programme 2021-2022 of the Department of Law, University of Mumbai

Candidates who have qualified the LL.M. CET Examination 2021 are required to follow the procedure as under:

**Candidates will have to fill the Google Form using the link as under on or before [23.10.2021 till 8.00 p.m.](https://forms.gle/Y2q2o8M2JF8wNCBy8)

The Qualified Candidates will have to provide the Department with their preferences on the LL.M Groups offered by the Department through Google forms. The Qualified Candidates will be required to state their preference against the respective LL.M Groups between Nos. 1 to 6.

‘1’ being the most preferred Group of the Qualified Candidate’s choice and ‘6’ being the least preferred Group of the Qualified Candidate’s choice for admission.

Once the Department receives and scrutinises the applications through Google Forms, the Department will publish the merit list in accordance with the applicable norms, rules, regulations of University of Mumbai and reservation policy of the

Government of Maharashtra & also subject to compliance with the requirements as stated herein.

On the basis of the information received as per the above forms, the merit list of candidates shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the Department of Law and shall also be uploaded on the webpage of the Department of Law, University of Mumbai (<https://mu.ac.in/departement-of-law>), which shall be notified in due course. The details of the subsequent procedure in respect of admission to the LL.M. Programme will be notified along with the Merit List.

In the event of equal marks secured by the candidates in the LL.M. CET, inter se merit will be decided as per marks secured in the LL.B. examination and in the event of equal marks secured by the candidate in the LL.B. examination, inter se merit will be decided as per the marks secured in HSC or equivalent examination.

In case there are vacant seats in any of the reserved categories, after the completion of admission rounds, such seats shall be converted and offered to appropriate categories as provided by inter changeability of Rules of Government of Maharashtra and applicable norms of the University of Mumbai.

In case the candidate has given inaccurate information or the candidate is found to be ineligible, the Department of Law reserves the right to cancel the admission of the candidate forthwith.
