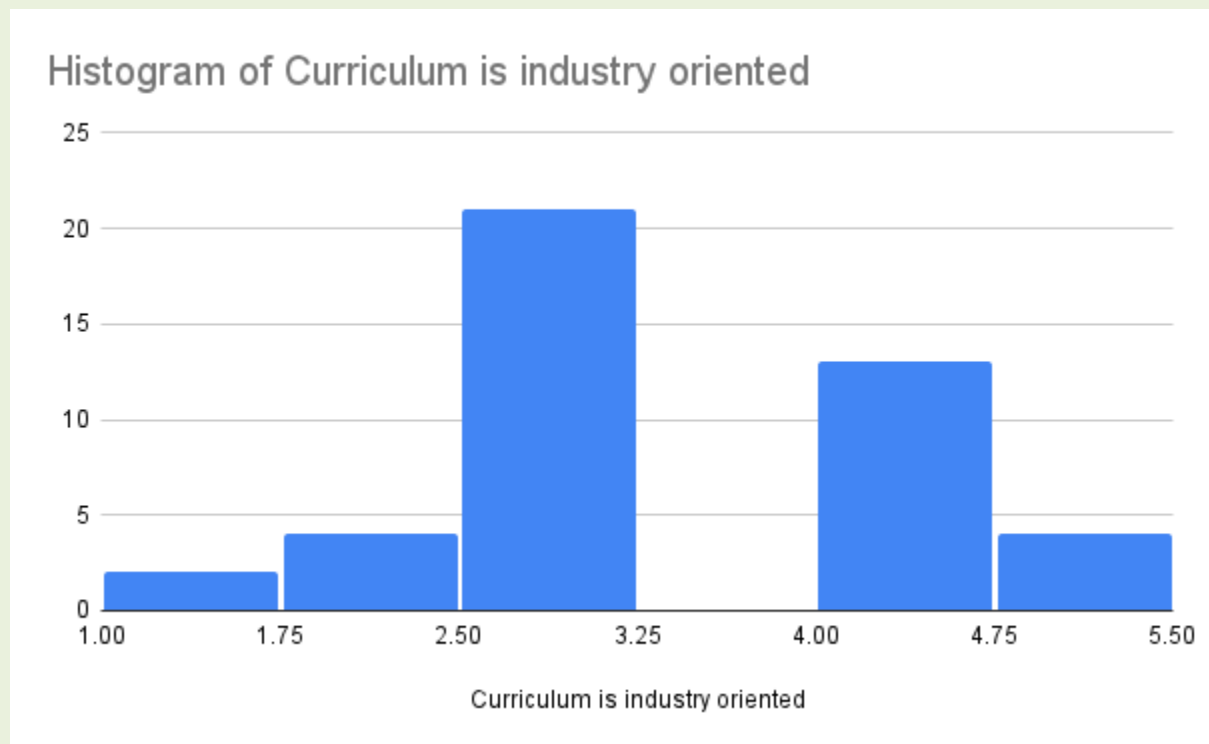

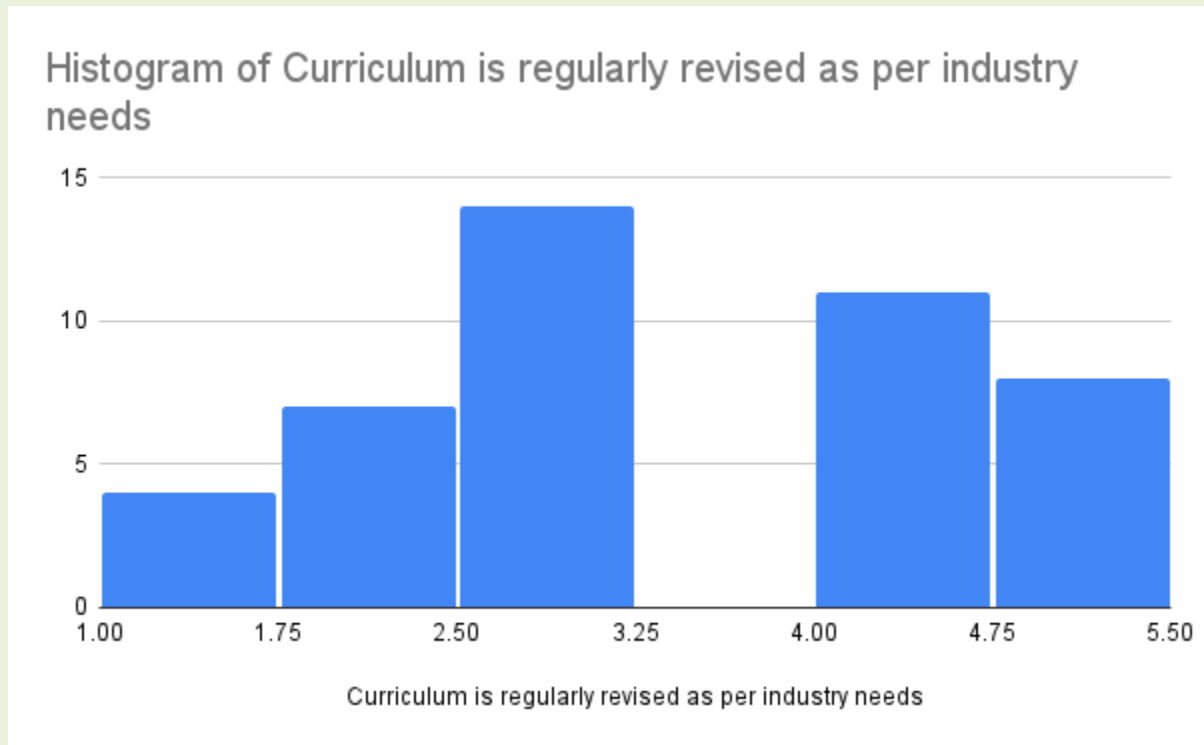
1 - Poor, 2 - Fair, 3 - Good, 4 - Very Good, 5 – Excellent

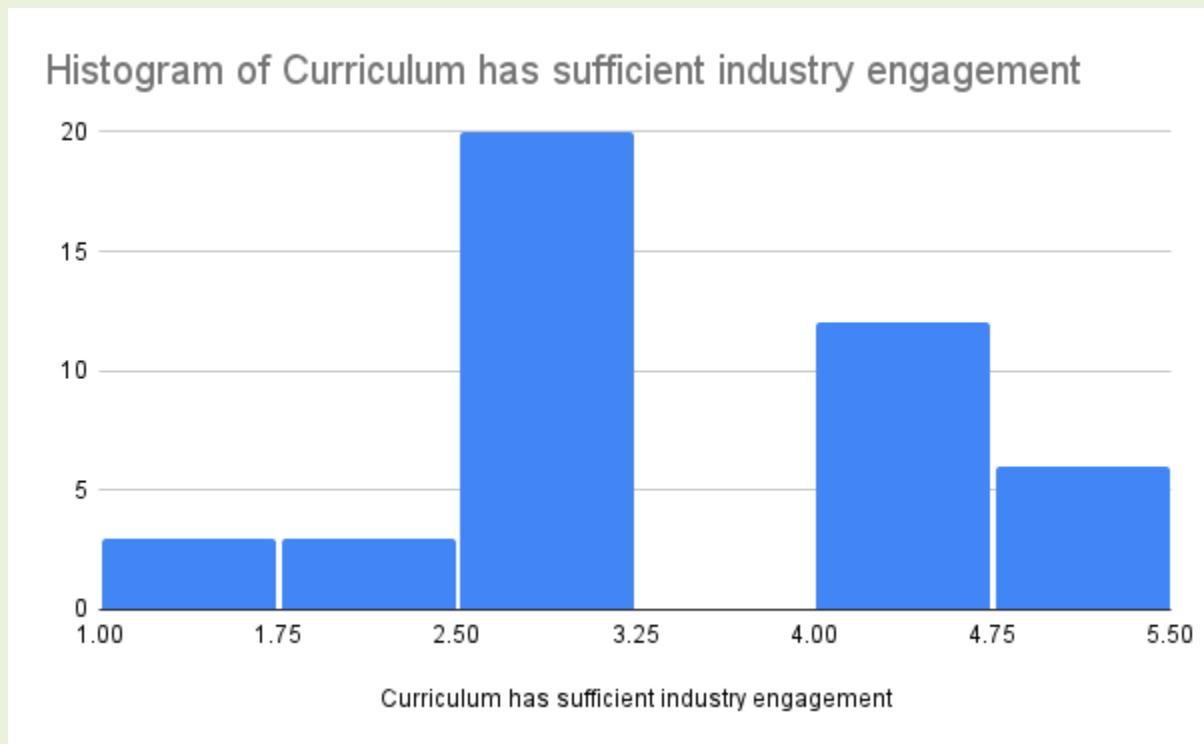
1. Curriculum is industry oriented



2. Curriculum is regularly revised as per industry needs

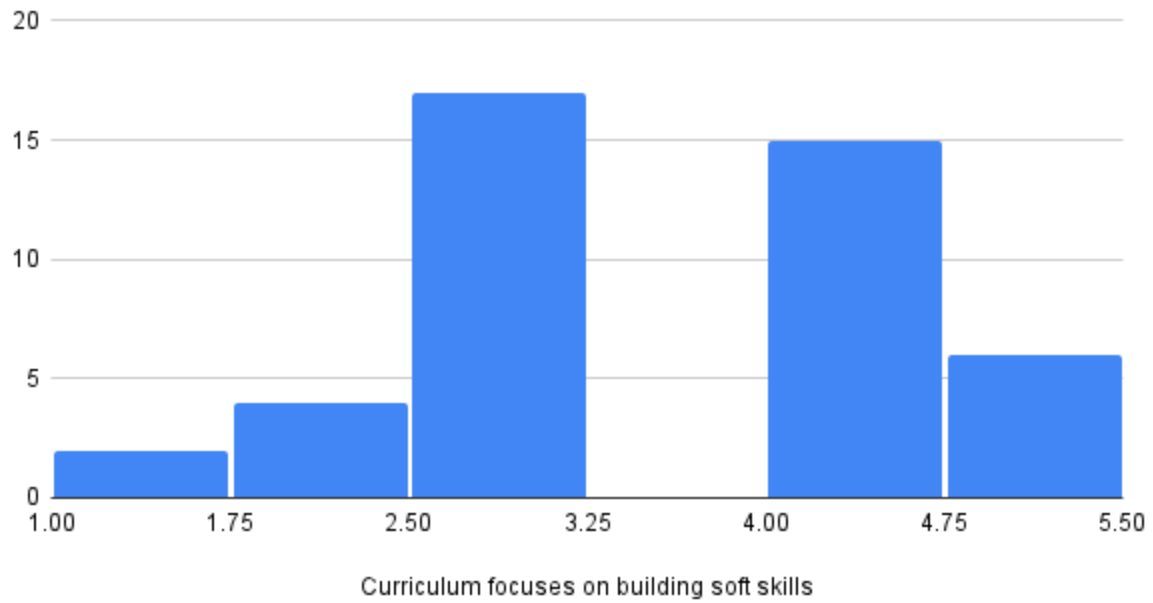


3. Curriculum has sufficient industry engagement



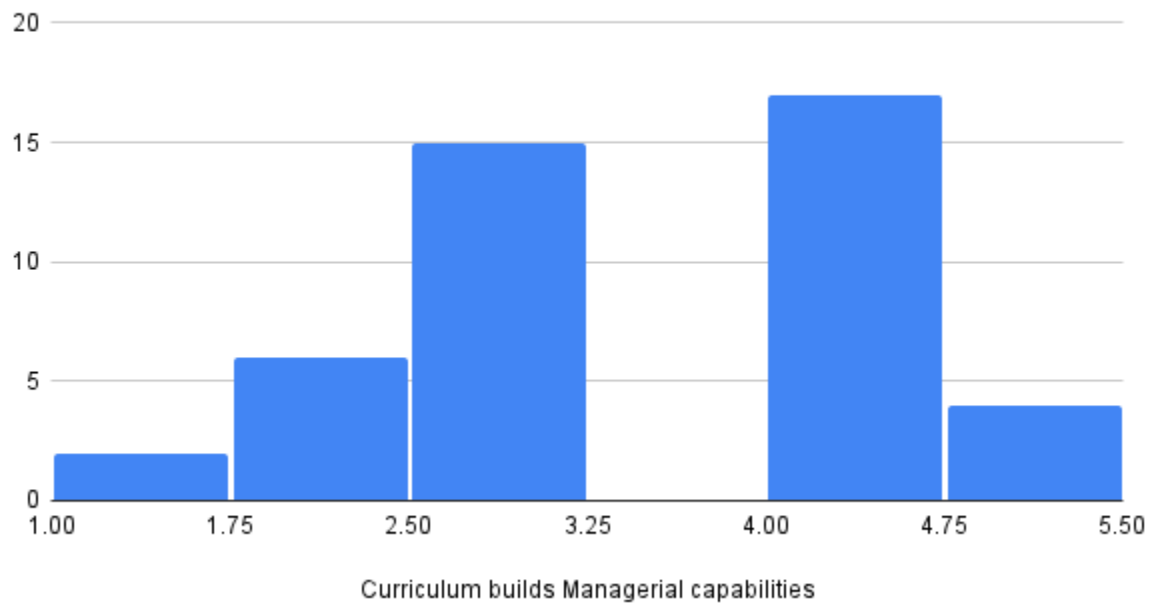
4. Curriculum focuses on building soft skills

Histogram of Curriculum focuses on building soft skills



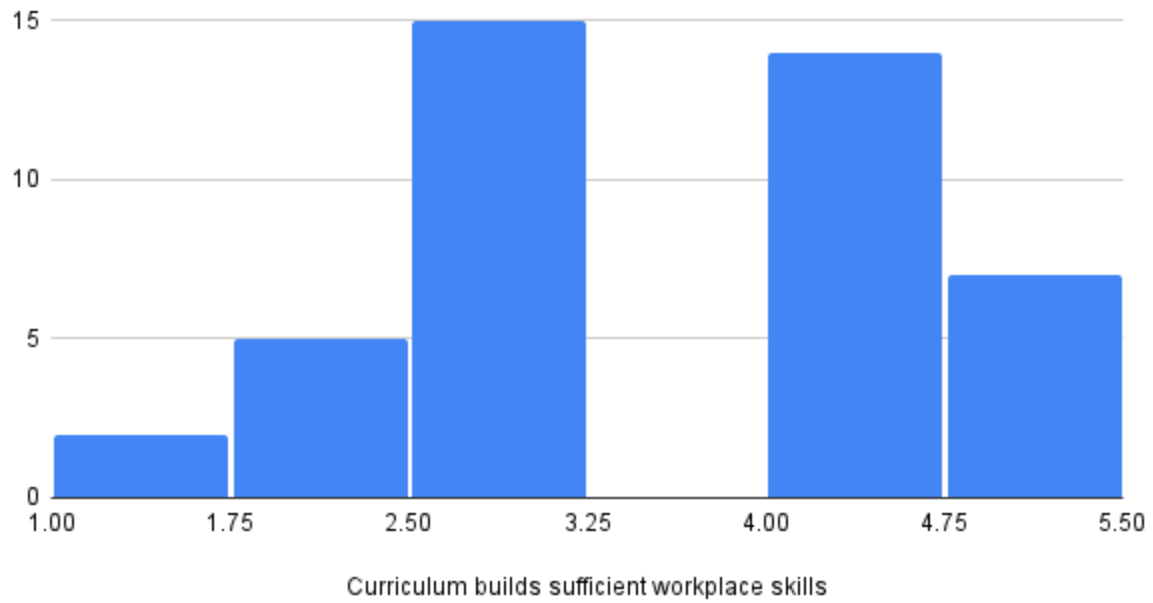
5. Curriculum builds Managerial capabilities

Histogram of Curriculum builds Managerial capabilities



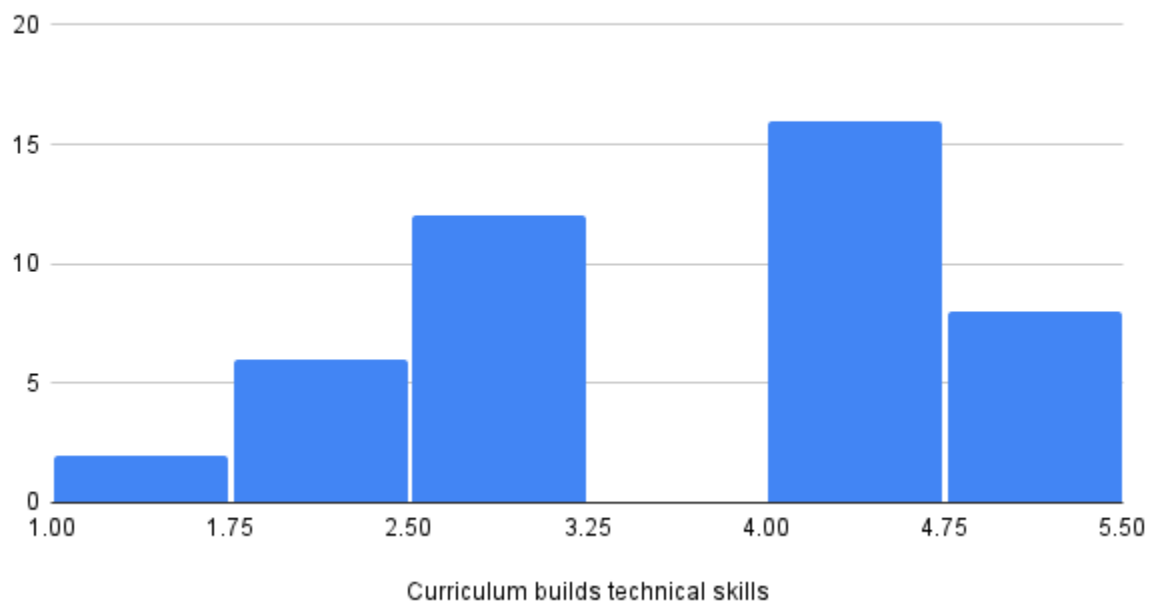
6. Curriculum builds sufficient workplace skills

Histogram of Curriculum builds sufficient workplace skills



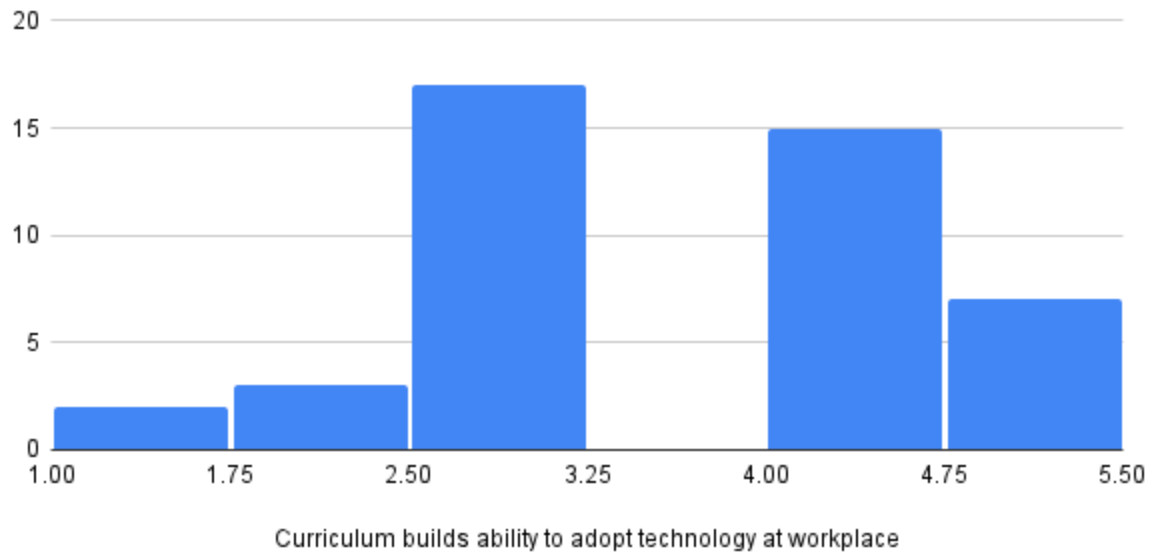

Histogram of Curriculum builds technical skills



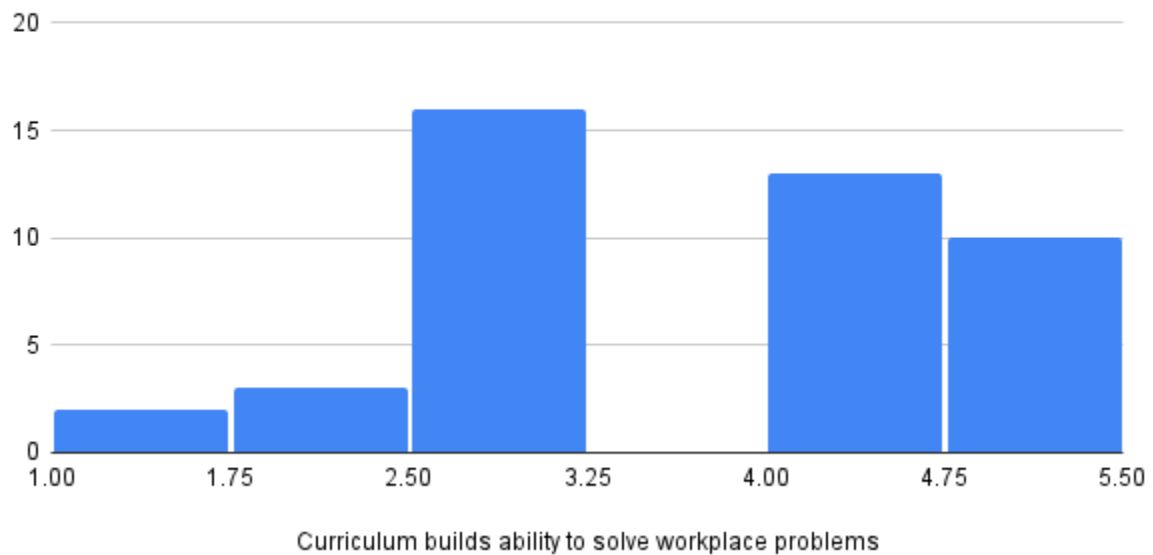

Histogram of Curriculum builds ability to adopt technology at workplace



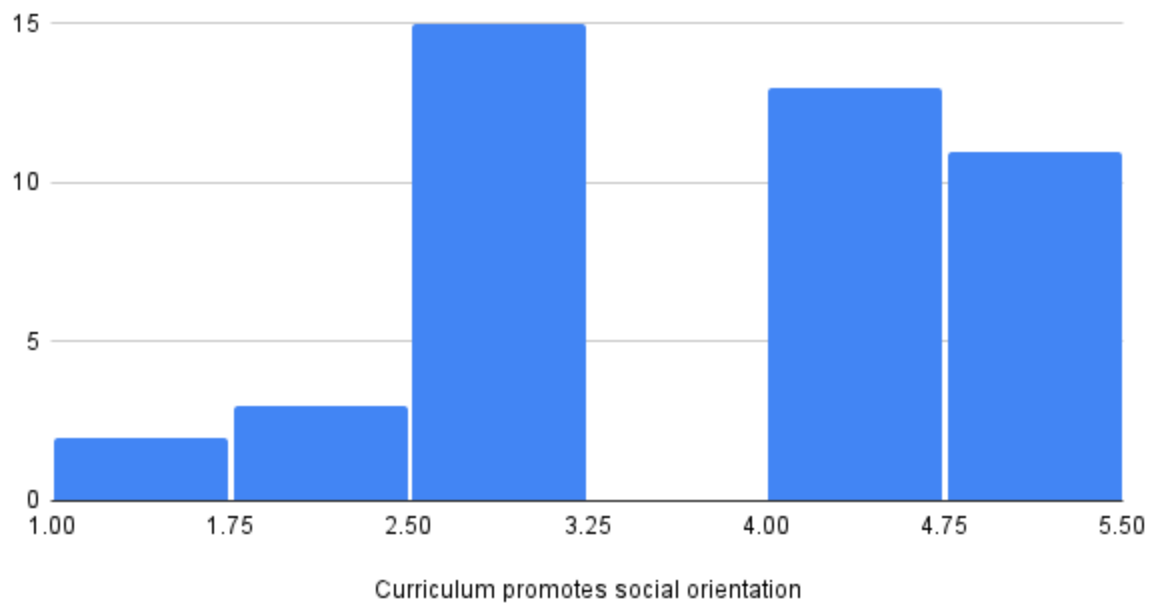
