INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

- 1) Application must be completed in all respects and must be uploaded on or before 4th July, 2022 on the **University Website :- uom-admission.mu.ac.in**.
- 2) *Applications must be filled in legibly.*
- 3) *The date for the Online Common Entrance Test is 8th July, 2022. Personal interviews will be held on 11th & 12th July, 2022*
- 4) A list of selected students for admission to the MSW will be exhibited on the **University Website** on 16th July 2022.
- 5) Candidates selected for admission are required to pay the fees and enroll themselves in the Centre between 16th to 19th July, 2022.
- 6) Applicants are requested to inform the Centre Office within 3 days from the date of publication of the list of selected candidates in case they do not wish to avail themselves of the seats offered, so as to enable the Centre to allot the vacant seats to the students on the waiting list. The students who fail to enroll within the period of 3 days will be allotted to others on the waiting list.
- 7) Graduates other than the University of Mumbai are required to submit their Self attested mark sheets for all the three graduation years for verification in the office of the Rajiv Gandhi Centre for Contemporary Studies.
- 8) Graduates of Universities other than the University of Mumbai are required to submit the Migration Certificate from their Graduating University within one week of taking admission in this University. Please note that it is the responsibility of the applicant to get the Migration Certificate, Mark Sheets and Verification of Mark Sheet from his/her University in time. In case the applicant is not able to get the migration certificate in time, their admission is liable to get cancelled and fees will not be refunded.
- 9) The applicant should be a graduate from any discipline from the recognized universities. The copies of the statements of marks obtained by applicants at the examination, certified by the Principal of a constituent college / the Head of a recognized institution or a Magistrate should be submitted. Further, the mark sheets must be in printed format only and NOT HAND-WRITTEN.
- 10) Application form must be completed in all respects and this will be provisional admission till your eligibility is cleared by University of Mumbai.

- The Candidate will thus be graded out of a total of 100 marks.
- Candidates for Group Discussion and Interview will be shortlisted on the basis of the marks achieved in Past Academic Record. (15), English Comprehension (15) and General Knowledge (10) taken together that is on the basis of marks scored out of 40.
- In the General Knowledge and the AIMS Test, Candidates will be tested on current social issues and debates in the country like health, education, development issues, tribal and rural welfare etc, and issues pertaining to the marginalized sections.

VERY IMPORTANT:

Candidates of University of Mumbai, whose Final Year Bachelors' exam results are pending will be allowed to appear for the Written Test, Group Discussion and Interview if shortlisted.

Candidates from other than Mumbai University, who are applied, will be allowed to appear for the Written Test ONLY if they provide their results / confidential results from their respective Universities or College. (Hence kindly contact your respective Universities in advance and do the needful)
