

Globalink Research Award Programme/SRSF Programme

Applications for Globalink Research Award Programme/SRSF Programme are invited by Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute for the year 2022-23. **Master's and Ph.D. students** (from the University Departments/Institutes/Centres) are eligible to apply for grants under this programme. **Postdoctoral fellows**, if any, may apply if their date of graduation from a PhD program is no more than 5 years prior to the proposed start date of the research project.

Background:

The Mitacs-SICI Globalink Research Awards can provide funding for research collaborations between Canadian and SICI member institutions. This program can be used to support large scale research collaborations (up to 5 interns per application) between SICI's Indian and Canadian member institutions, as well as individual research projects. Eligible participants (Master's, PhD, Postdocs) from India and Canada (each way) apply to conduct joint research projects with academic collaborators/supervisors at SICI's Indian / Canadian member universities for a period of 12-24 weeks (25% of the time can be spent at the home institution). Master's or Ph.D Students and Post-doctoral fellows from SICI member Institutions in India and Canada will travel to the other country to work on research projects at SICI Member Institutions for 12-24 weeks

Value of Award: 6000 CAD

This includes student airfare, visa, medical insurance, living stipend, research related costs, student stipend, accommodation costs, programming, evaluation, professional development, administration, and research costs.

Deadline: The Programme is open to receive applications **throughout the year**. However, once the numbers of designated awards are made, the programme will close. Since this is a competitive opportunity and a limited number of awards are available, applicants are advised to apply at their earliest to secure an award.
