Notification for Admission to Ph.D. (2022-23- Winter Session)

The Department of Civics & Politics, University of Mumbai is inviting applications for admission to Ph.D. in Politics. The candidates who have cleared NET/SET/PET/M.Phil. in Politics or those from other disciplines and have also cleared subject change/faculty change examination should apply for the Ph.D. Programme online.

Interested candidates are hereby instructed to apply on the official registration portal of the University of Mumbai: https://uomphd.mu.ac.in/index.php

The interested candidates should first register themselves and then login. The Tutorial link is given on the portal which gives the step by step demonstration of the registration process.

The candidates are required to upload the scanned- self-attested photocopies of the following documents/certificates while submitting the online application:

- 1. Bachelor Degree Certificate, Passing Certificate and all semester pattern/annual pattern Marksheets (self-attested) in single PDF file.
- 2. Master Degree Certificate, Passing Certificate and all semester pattern/annual pattern Marksheets (self-attested)- in single PDF file.
- 3. PET/NET/SET/M.Phil (Degree Certificate, Passing Certificate and Marksheet/s) self-attested certificate copy- in single PDF file.
- 4. Caste certificate (if applicable)
- 5. Subject change/ Faculty change examination certificate (if applicable)

Those who are from disciplines other than Politics should have passed NET/SET/PET/M.Phil in their respective subjects and also should have passed the faculty change examination conducted by the Department of Civics and Politics, University of Mumbai. Such candidates should attach the certificate of the subject change/faculty change examination along with all the certificates mentioned above. Students who are opting for 'Subject Change' or 'Faculty Change' are instructed to contact the department (email id: office.udcp@politics.mu.ac.in) on or before November 2, 2022.
