Attention of the Principals of the Affiliated Colleges, Directors of the Recognized Institutions in Faculty of Inter-Disciplinary Studies is invited to this office Circular No.UG/368 of 2001 dated 20<sup>th</sup> October, 2001, relating to the LL.B. degree course.

They are hereby informed that the recommendations made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Law at its meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 vide item No.1 (a) and subsequently passed by the Board of Deans at its meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 vide item No.8.6 (A) have been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 vide item No. 8.6 (A) and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its online meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 vide item No. 8 and that in accordance therewith, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 74(4) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 (Mah. Act No. VI of 2017) for the amendment of **amendment of R 4465 relating to the eligibility for admission to the third semester of 3 years LL.B. course, amendment of R 4469 relating to the eligibility for admission to the fifth semester of 3 years LL.B. course, amendment of R 4453 relating to the eligibility for admission to the seventh semester of 5 years LL.B. course and amendment of R 4457 relating to the eligibility for admission to the ninth semester of 5 years LL.B. course** from the academic year 2022-23, accordingly. (The same is available on the University's website [www.mu.ac.in](http://www.mu.ac.in)) and to read as under:-

**amendment of R 4465 relating to the eligibility for admission to the third semester of 3 years LL.B. course, amendment of R 4469 relating to the eligibility for admission to the fifth semester of 3 years LL.B. course, amendment of R 4453 relating to the eligibility for admission to the seventh semester of 5 years LL.B. course and amendment of R 4457 relating to the eligibility for admission to the ninth semester of 5 years LL.B. course.**

**Existing R 4465:-**

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the third semester of 3 years LL.B. course must have either passed in the examinations of the first and second semester or must have got exemption in at least six papers (excluding Practical Training Paper) of the first and second semesters.

**Amended R 4465:-**

For promotion of LL B students to higher class from semester II to III of 3 yrs programme. the students have to clear atleast 7 courses out of 10 courses of the year from which promotion is applied for including the courses on applied components.

**Existing R 4469:-**

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the fifth semester of 3 years LL.B. course must have either passed in all the papers of first and second semesters and must have either passed in the third and fourth semesters or must have got exemption in at least six papers (excluding Practical Training Paper) of the third and fourth semesters.

**Amended R 4469:-**

For promotion of LL B students to higher class from semester IV to V of 3yrs programme, the students have to clear atleast 7 courses out of 10 courses of the year from which promotion is applied for including the courses on applied components.

**Existing R 4453:-**

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the seventh semester of 5 years LL.B. course must have passed in all the papers of first to fourth semesters or must have got exemption in at least six papers (excluding Practical Training Paper) of the fifth and sixth semesters.

**Amended R 4453:-**

For promotion of LL B students to higher from semester VI to VII of 5 yrs programme, the students have to clear at least 7 courses out of 10 courses of the year from which promotion is applied for including the courses on applied components.

**Existing R 4457:-**

A candidate for being eligible for admission to the ninth semester of 5 years LL.B. course must have passed in all the papers of first to sixth semesters and must have got exemption in at least six papers (excluding Practical Training Paper) of the seventh and ninth semesters.

**Amended R 4457:-**

For promotion of LL B students to higher from semester VIII to IX of 5 yrs programme, the students have to clear at least 7 courses out of 10 courses of the year from which promotion is applied for including the courses on applied components.
