Report on the Study India Day hosted at the University of Münster, Germany 22 November 2022

The Study India Certificate course of the Westfälische Wilhelms University of Münster's Department of English (British and Postcolonial Studies), with the Collaborative Research Centre 1385 "Law and Literature", University of Münster, Germany, and the Mumbai Münster Institute of Advanced Studies (MMIAS), University of Mumbai, had organised a symposium on 'India at 75 from a Law and Literature Perspective', on the occasion of Study India Day, on 22nd November 2022 at the University of Münster, Germany.
