(Music).

They are hereby informed that the recommendations made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Music at its meeting held on 23rd August, 2022 <u>vide</u> item No. 6 and subsequently passed by the Board of Deans at its online meeting held on 08th December, 2022 <u>vide</u> item No. 8.16 (A) have been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 06th April, 2023 <u>vide</u> item No. 8.16 (A) and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its online meeting held on 27th April, 2023 <u>vide</u> item No. 11 and that in accordance therewith, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 74(4) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 (Mah. Act No. VI of 2017) for the amendment of **R. 4264 relating to the standard of passing for B.P.A. (Music)** from the academic year 2023-24 and to read as under :-

Amendment of R. 4264 relating to the standard of passing for B.P.A. (Music).

Existing R. 4264 -

To pass the examination a candidate must obtain a minimum of 40% marks in each theory paper, a minimum of 50% marks in Internal Assessment and a minimum of 50% marks in each Practical Paper.

Those of the successful candidate who obtain 60% or more of the total marks will be placed in the 'B' grade. Those obtaining 70% or more marks will be placed in the 'A' grade. Those obtaining 80% or more of the total marks will be declared to have passed in the 'A' grade with Distinction. All successful candidates other than those who have been place in the 'B' or 'A' grade will be placed in the 'C' grade.

In the discussion it was found that this passing standard is much higher than practice standards in other universities running similar courses/program.

Amended R. 4264 -

To pass the examination a candidate must obtain a minimum of 40% marks in each theory paper, a minimum of 40% marks in Internal Assessment and a minimum of 40% mark sin each Practical Paper.

Those of the successful candidate who obtain 60% or more of the total marks will be placed in the 'B' grade. Those obtaining 70% or more marks will be placed in the 'A' grade. Those obtaining 80% or more of the total marks will be declared to have passed in the 'A' grade with Distinction. All successful candidates other than those who have been placed in the 'B' or 'A' grade will be placed in the 'C' grade.
