

M.A. (Sociology) Admission 2023-2024

This is to inform you all those who are seeking admission for M.A. (Sociology) programme at Department of Sociology, University of Mumbai. The online admission process for MA (Sociology) stared from 21st July, 2023. The link for online registration/application is available on University website https://muadmission.samarth.edu.in

All students who have filled pre-registration form for M.A. (Sociology) programme are requested to register on University portal and fill the online application form for admission. The pre-registration link on Department webpage will be closed now as University portal is open for students who wish to take admission at Department of Sociology.

Kindly note the following procedure for admission.

- · Direct admission to those students who have passed B.A. with six papers in Sociology.
- Interviews will be taken of those students who have passed B.A. with three papers in Sociology.
- There will be a Faculty Change/Aptitude Test for students from other than Sociology subject.

Schedule of Faculty Change/ Aptitude Test and Interview

Faculty Change/Aptitude Test on 8th August, 2023 Time – 11.00 to 01.00 Interview on 8th August, 2023

Time - 02.00 pm onwards

Venue - Seminar room, Department of Sociology, University of Mumbai.

Any graduate other than B.A. Sociology who wish to seek admission to M.A. Sociology need to clear Faculty Change/ Aptitude Test. The syllabus for this exam is same as the syllabus for B.A. Sociology, University of Mumbai. The exam will be of 70 marks and interview will be of 30 marks. Students with 3 papers in Sociology at B.A. level have to appear for interview.

Performance at the Faculty Change/ Aptitude Test and interview as well as the grades/marks received at the Bachelor's Degree Examination will be considered for deciding admission at the Department.

Admission at Department will be subject to final verification of all documents, eligibility criteria and reservation rules of the Government of Maharashtra and University of Mumbai in this regards. Violation of any procedure/rules may lead to cancellation of admission at any point of time.
