Instructions for Psychological Testing and Psychometrics Practical Exam M.A. (CBCS) Semester II

1. Check your practical exam batch which is shared with you for the date and time of practical exams.

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- 2. The practical exam will be conducted in the laboratory at the Department of Applied Psychology, University of Mumbai. You are supposed to report to the laboratory 20 minutes before the timing of the batch assigned to you.
- 3. You are required to get along with you 1 participant who is 18 years and above (Your current classmates are not allowed to be your participant). You are also required to carry your hall ticket and the hard copy of your certified journal to the exam.
- 4. You will be randomly assigned one of the 7 psychometric scales/tools developed by you all in your Semester II practical course.
- 5. Your tasks for the practical examination are the following
 - a. Give instructions of the scale/tool assigned to you in front of the examiner, and administer the scale to your participant. Score and interpret participants responses on the scale administered.
 - b. You will have to write a report on the scale administered by you (using report writing format introduced to you, which may include e.g. introduction, psychometric properties, uses/applications etc.). The report should include interpretation of only individual data (Participants score). You are not required to analyze any group data.
 - c. You are required to appear for Viva voce by the examiner during the exam, upon being called for the same.
- 6. The scale, scoring key and norms table for interpretation of scores will be provided to you.
