The Mumbai Münster Institute of Advanced Studies (MMIAS), University of Mumbai, invites applications from scholars for the position of MMIAS Fellow for a minimum duration of 6 months to a maximum duration of 11 months in the calendar year 2024.

The MMIAS expects the Fellow to deliver the following:

1. Research Project

As MMIAS Fellow, you shall submit a detailed outline of the Research Project you would be working on at the beginning of your tenure. You shall further work on the project during your term as decided at the time of appointment and submit the finished research project in the form of a report and make an oral presentation at the end of the Fellowship.

2. Public Lecture

As MMIAS Fellow, you will deliver 1 public lecture on a topic of your choice preferably from the core areas that the Institute operates in. Please find below the list of core areas for your ready reference:

- Political, Social, Cultural and Economic Aspects of Diaspora Studies
- Law and Literature
- Cultural Links, Trade and Commerce in the Indian Ocean Littoral States
- India's Diplomatic and Security Role in the Indian Ocean Region
- Asian Studies related specially to the History, Politics and Economics of South Asia
- Other related Historical, Political, Diplomatic and Financial areas of Higher Research

The MMIAS shall provide a modest honorarium for this lecture.

3. Contribution in the form of workshops/seminars for the MMIAS

The Fellow shall conduct workshops/seminars for the students, researchers and interns at the MMIAS, University of Mumbai, and other invited scholars either online/offline or in a hybrid mode. The MMIAS shall provide a modest honorarium for these workshops/seminars.
