

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made and entered into as on 19 Day of 00008ER 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the "Effective Date"),

Collectively referred to as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, Go Shoonya Pvt Ltd, is India's first start-up by NSS Volunteers and Program officers, a Social Enterprise committed to environmental conservation and sustainable development. Our organization has been actively involved in various projects that promote environmental sustainability and social responsibility. Go Shoonya Pvt Ltd was incorporated on 24th of September 2021 and incubated by MU Ideas.

WHEREAS, the University of Mumbai is an esteemed educational institution committed to promoting sustainable practices and environmental awareness.

WHEREAS, Go Shoonya and the University of Mumbai share a mutual interest in promoting a sustainable and environmentally conscious campus environment.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, the Parties hereby agree to collaborate and enter into this MOU under the following terms and conditions:

1. Purpose and Scope:

- 1.1. The purpose of this MOU is to outline the collaboration between Go Shoonya and the University of Mumbai to establish a Material Recovery Facility (MRF) and Recycling Centre within the Vidyanagri campus.
- 1.2. The MRF and Recycling Centre aim to convert the Vidyanagri campus into a Zero Waste campus, promoting waste reduction, recycling, and environmentally friendly waste management practices.

2. Project Overview:

2.1. Go Shoonya, in collaboration with its NGO and CSR partners, will finance and oversee the development and operation of the MRF and Recycling Centre.

2.2. The University of Mumbai will allocate approximately 10,000 square feet of space for the MRF and 5,000 square feet for the Recycling Centre within the Vidyanagri campus.

3. Responsibilities:

3.1. **Go Shoonya Responsibilities:** a. Develop, operate, and maintain the MRF and Recycling Centre. b. Provide necessary expertise, technology, and manpower for efficient waste management. c. Collaborate with CSR partners to secure funding for the project.

3.2. University of Mumbai Responsibilities: a. Allocate the specified space within the Vidyanagri campus for the MRF and Recycling Centre. b. Assist in obtaining required permissions and approvals for the project. c. Collaborate in promoting and implementing waste reduction and recycling initiatives within the campus.

4. Financials:

4.1. Go Shoonya will finance the MRF and Recycling Centre using CSR funds obtained in collaboration with its CSR partners.

4.2. The University of Mumbai will not incur any financial liability for the development, operation, or maintenance of the MRF and Recycling Centre.

5. Duration:

This MOU shall be effective from the Effective Date and shall remain in force for a period of 11 years unless terminated earlier by mutual agreement of the Parties.

6. Termination:

This MOU may be terminated by mutual written agreement of the Parties or in the event of a breach of terms as outlined herein.
