3. **Recent Passport Size Photographs** (Five copies, 45 x 35 mm, **background of the photo should be light grey**, bareheaded).
4. **No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the University** for his / her participation in WUG-2025 (Germany).

Annexure-I

GUIDELINES FOR THE SELECTION OF INDIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY TEAMS/ATHLETES for WUG-2025

FISU GENERAL REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

1.General Eligibility

The athletes:

- Be at least 18 and not older than 25 years of age on the 31st December of the event for 2025, athletes must be born between 01-01-2000 and 31-12-2007.
- In FISU sports event must represent the same country as in their respective international federation Athletes participating events.
- The player must be a bonafide student of their respective University or former students of the universities who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the calendar year preceding the event.

2.Game Specific Eligibility of Players/Teams for participation in Selection Trials of the Indian Universities Team (Men & Women).

Volleyball (Women)

- I. All the members of top 2 (two) ranked teams of the last Khelo India University Games.
- II. All the members of top 2 (two) ranked teams of the All India Inter University Games 2024.
- III. All the members of top 2 (two) ranked teams of Khelo India Youth Games 2024
- IV. The best 4 (four) players from the 2 (two) semi finalist teams & best 3 (three) players from the remaining 4 (four) teams out of the top 8 (eight) teams that participated in the last Khelo India University Games, All India Inter University Games and Khelo India Youth Games 2024. The players to be recommended by the Director Sports of respective Universities.
- V. An international player who has represented India in Senior or Junior categories of last 2 (two) years (from 1st Feb 2023 onward).
- VI. Players who were a member of top 3 (three) teams of Senior or Junior nationals of last 2 (two) years (from 1st Feb 2023 onward).
- VII. The Director Sports of each University may forward 1 (one) exceptional player of concerned university who is not coming under the above mentioned categories (with sufficient credentials) for the consideration of the selection committee with prior approval from AIU.

Lawn Tennis (Men & Women)

- I. All the members of top 2 (two) ranked teams of the last Khelo India University Games.
- II. All the members of top 2 (two) ranked teams of the All India Inter University Games 2024.
- III. All the members of top 2 (two) ranked teams of Khelo India Youth Games 2024
- IV. The top 3 (three) players from the 2 (two) semi finalist teams & top 2 (two) players from the remaining 4 (four) teams out of the top 8 (eight) teams that participated in the last Khelo India University Games, All India Inter University Games and Khelo India Youth Games 2024. The players to be recommended by the Director Sports of respective Universities.
- V. An international player who has represented India in Senior or Junior categories of last 2 (two) years (from 1st Feb 2023 onward).
- VI. Players who were a member of top 3 (three) teams of Senior or Junior nationals of last 2 (two) years (from 1st Feb 2023 onward).
- VII. The Director Sports of each University may forward 1 (one) exceptional player of concerned university who is not coming under the above mentioned categories (with sufficient credentials) for the consideration of the selection committee with prior approval from AIU.

3. General Guidelines for Selection.

- Merit will be based on Individual performance and not the Team performances.
- In weighing sports, the weighing will be done as per rule, i.e. one day before the event at 4:00 pm (with hard copies of all documents).
- The decision of the selection committee will be final and binding.
- Boarding and Lodging shall be provided by the host/organizing University on payment basis at the competition venue.
- After the selection trial, a national training camp will be organized allocated by AIU to a member University and the information of the same will be conveyed to the respective universities in due course of time.
- The committee has the right to select the best athlete in the country, in case the policy is silent with prior approval from AIU.

4. Important Note:

- FISU has not imposed any restrictions on athletes employed in either the Government or private sector from participating in the selection trials, provided They meet all other eligibility criteria.
