(Banking and Insurance) degree course vide Pamphlet Mo.351 and to this office Circular No. UG/244 of 2003 dated 11<sup>th</sup> June. 2003 and they are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Board of Studies in Commerce at its meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2004 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2004 vide item No.4.2 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2004 vide item No.22 and that in accordance therewith the O.5209 relating to the eligibility criteria prescribed for admission to the B.Com.(Banking and Insurance) degree course has been amended to read as under:

O.5209 - A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Commerce (Banking and Insurance) Degree Course should have passed XII Std. Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Pune, cruits equivalent and secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate (40% in the case of reserved category candidates) at one and the same sitting. Every candidate admitted to the Degree Course in the affiliated colleges conducting the course shall have to register enrol himself/herself with the University.

Further that the amended 0.5209 has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.
