

R.4164 :- A candidate must complete the entire course successfully within the span of five academic years from the date of **P.G. Registration** of the course, failing which the candidate shall have to register afresh.

If a candidate has to discontinue his/her studies due to some unavoidable circumstances, he/she can re-register himself/herself within five years from the date of first registration.

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi relating to the Master of Education (M.E.) degree course vide pamphlet No.160 and to this office Circular No.UG/369 of 2003, dated 1st August,2003 the Head, University Department of Education and the Principals of the training Education Colleges are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the Board of Studies in Education at its meeting held on 8th May,2008 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 25th September,2008 vide Item No.4.20 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 4th October,2008 vide item No.4 and that in accordance therewith, in the exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 55(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994, it has amended Regulation 4320,4323 and 4324 relating to the M.Ed. degree course to read as under and that the same will be brought into force with effect from the academic year 2009-2010:-

R. 4320:- The dissertation shall be on an educational topic approved by the scrutiny committee consisting of members of the Board of Studies in Education as well as four additional members including two recognised post-graduate teachers having guided at least five dissertations at the M.Ed. level and two recognised Ph.D. guides of University of Mumbai having successfully guided at least two Ph.D. theses / M.Phil. dissertations. If a topic suggested by any student is not approved, he/she will be at liberty to suggest another, provided that in all such cases the topic is got approved by the committee. Each student shall work under the guidance of a recognized post-graduate teacher for his/her dissertation.

R. 4323. To pass the examination the candidate must obtain:

- In part A, minimum 35% of marks separately in each paper and 40% of marks in aggregate.
- In part B, minimum 50% marks.
- With respect to the total marks obtained by the candidate in Part A of the examination (out of total 600), and in Part B (out of total 200) class will be accorded to the candidates as follows:-

| Class | Percentage | Marks |
|--|---------------|---------------|
| 1 st Class with Distinction | 70% and above | 560 and above |
| 1 st Class | 60% to 69% | 480 – 559 |
| 2 nd Class | 50% to 59% | 400 – 479 |
| Pass Class | 40% to 49% | 320 – 399 |
| Fail | Below 40% | 319 and below |

The class will be awarded on the basis of the total performance of parts A and B taken together.

R.432.4:- If the candidate passes in theory papers but fails in the dissertation the marks in theory papers will be carried over, at his/her option, to three subsequent examinations. Candidates exercising this option will not be eligible for First or Second Class. If the candidate passes in the dissertation but fails in theory papers, the marks in dissertation will be carried over, at his/her option, to three subsequent examinations. Candidates exercising this option will not be eligible for First or Second Class.
