Sir,

I am to invite your attention to the scheme of papers relating to the degree of Master of Performing Art (M.P.A.) (Music) and to this office Circular No.UG/157 of 2000 dated 10th May, 2000 and to inform you that the following recommendations made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Hindustani Music at its meeting held on 10th December, 2003 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 2nd April, 2004 **vide Item No. 4.46** and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 17th April, 2004 (**vide item No.20**) and that in accordance therewith the Ordinance 4011 relating to the eligibility criteria for admission to the Master of Performing Art. (M.P.A.) in Music is amended to read as under :

O.4011 :- A candidate for being eligible for admission to the course for the degree of Master of Performing Art (Music-Vocal)-M.P.A.(Music-Vocal) must have passed -

- (a) Bachelor of Performing Art (Music-Vocal) of this University or a degree of any other University or body recognized as equivalent thereto.

OR

- (b) Bachelor of Art of any other University or body recognized by this University with specialization in the subject of Music.

OR

- (c) Passing of any other Music examination recognized by this University provided the candidate is Bachelor's degree holder of any other recognized University.

OR

- (d) The "Sangeet Visharad" examination from the Akhil Bhartiya Gandharva Mahavidyalaya Mandal, Mumbai provided the candidate is a Bachelor's degree holder of any recognized University.

Provided, however, persons with outstanding performing abilities and sufficient theoretical knowledge in the field of Music who are graduates in any faculty of this University or of any recognized University may be admitted to this post-graduate degree course on the recommendation of the Head of the Institute in which they seek admission.

All the candidates seeking admission except those holding B.P.A. (Music) degree of this University securing 'A' and above grades will have to appear for audition test to be conducted by the Head of the Institution where the admission is sought.

Further that the amended Ordinance 4011 will be brought into force with effect from the academic year 2004-2005.
