Pattern of Question Papers For F.Y.B.A. & S.Y.B.A. in Statistics

(With effect from academic year 2008-2009
and 2009-2010 respectively)

Examination : F.Y.B.A.

Theory Examination : Term end Examination will be of duration of two hours

Pattern of question paper of Theory Examination

The first term Examination shall consist of four questions with internal option

Q1. Based on unit no.1,2 and 3 [14 Marks]

Q2. Based on unit no.1 [12 Marks]

Q3. Based on unit no.2 [12 Marks]

Q4. Based on unit no.3. [12 Marks]

The Second term Examination of each paper shall consist of four questions with internal option.

Q1. Based on unit no.4,5 and 6. [14 Marks]

Q2. Based on unit no.4 [12 Marks]

Q3. Based on unit no.5 [12 Marks]

Q4. Based on unit no.6 [12 Marks]

Practical Examination :

Practical Examination will be conducted at the end of year.

It shall consist one paper and duration of which will be 3 hours. The paper shall have two questions (with internal options) carrying 15 marks each.

First question will be based on unit no.1,2,3 and Second question will be based on unit no.4,5,6.

Marks to the extent of five shall be reserved for the conduct in Computer Practicals.

[15 + 15 = 30] + 5 - 5 = 40.

Examination : S.Y.B.A.

Theory Examination : Term end Examination of each paper will be of duration of two hours

Pattern of question paper of Theory Examination

The First term Examination of each paper shall consist of four questions with internal option.

Q1. Based on unit no.1,2 and 3 [14 Marks]

Q2. Based on unit no.1 [12 Marks]

Q3. Based on unit no.2 [12 Marks]

Q4. Based on unit no.3. [12 Marks]

The Second term Examination of each paper shall consist of four questions with internal option.

Q1. Based on unit no.4,5 and 6. [14 Marks]

Q2. Based on unit no.4 [12 Marks]

Q3. Based on unit no.5 [12 Marks]

Q4. Based on unit no.6 [12 Marks]

Practical Examination

Practical Examination will be conducted at the end of year.

It shall consist of two papers based on content of paper II and paper III respectively. Duration of each will be 3 hours. Each paper shall have two questions (with internal options) carrying 15 marks each. First question will be based on unit no.1,2,3 and Second question will be based on unit no.4,5,6.

Marks to the extent of Ten shall be reserved for the conduct in Computer Practicals.
