I am to invite your attention to this office Circular No. UG/237 of 2009 dated 23rd June, 2009 relating to the Master of Music (M.Mus.) degree course and to inform you that the recommendation made by the Chairperson of the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Hindustani Music has been accepted by the Ag. Vice-Chancellor and that, in accordance therewith, the Regulation 4270 now to read as under:-

- R. 4270 (i):- Those of the successful candidates who obtain 50% or more of the total marks in Part I and Part II examination taken together will be placed in the 'C'.

 Grade, those who obtain 60% or more of the total marks will be placed in 'B' Grade and those who obtain 70% or more marks will be declared to have passed the examination in 'A' Grade. Those who obtain 80% or more will be declared to have passed the examination 'A' Grade with Distinction.
 - (ii) An unsuccessful candidate shall be allowed to reappear for all the theory and practical papers directly without taking readmission and his/her internal assessment marks shall be carried forward if the candidate has passed the internal assessment and he/she claim the exemption. Such a candidate will not be eligible award if 'A' or 'B' grade, prize or scholarship at examination.

(iii) A candidate who fails in Internal Assessment has to take readmission in the same class.

A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Management Studies vide Pamphlet No.309 and to this office circular No.UG/442 dated 27th November, 2009 and the Principals of the affiliated collages in Commerce are hereby informed that recommendation made by the Dean Faculty of Commerce has been accepted by the Ag. Vice-Chancellor in the matter of amended Regulation 4166 relating to the standard of passing of the B.M.S. degree course and that, in accordance therewith, Regulation 4166 relating to the standard of passing B.M.S. degree course now to read as under:-

Regulation. 4166:-

- i) A Student must get 50% of the marks in aggregate of Internal and Semester End examination with minimum of 40% marks in the internal and semester end examinations separately to pass the subject (For a student to pass the subject, the student must secure minimum of 40% of the marks allotted (i.e. 40 out of 100) in the internal and semester end examinations with minimum of 40% marks in internal and external examinations separately (16 out of 40 and 24 out of 60 marks separately.)
- ii) A candidate shall be placed in First Class with Distinction if he/she secures a minimum of 50% marks in each theory paper and with a minimum Grade of C in each project in Semester V & VI and at least 70% marks in theory papers of Semester V & VI taken together in aggregate.
- iii) A candidate shall be placed in First Class if he/she secures a minimum of 50% marks in each theory paper and with a minimum Grade of C in each project in Semester V & VI and at least 60% marks in theory papers of Semester V &VI taken together in aggregate.
- iv) Carry forward of the Marks in case if the student fails in one or more subjects :
 - a) A candidate who fails in any particular theory papers shall be allowed to reappear for that theory papers. However, his/her internal evaluation marks shall be carried over. But he/she shall not be entitled to any class on passing.
 - b) A candidate who passed in the Semester End (Theory) examination of any subject but fails in the internal examination shall appear for the internal examination of that subject only. The internal examination will consist of one project of 40 marks and the same is to be divided into: 10 marks for the presentation, 20 marks for the hard copy of the project and 10 for the viva. However his/her Semester End Examinations shall be carried forward but the student will not be entitled to any class on passing.

- v) (a) A candidate shall be allowed to keep terms for Semester II if he/she passes Semester I OR if he/she fails in not more than two theory papers of Semester I.
 - (b) A candidate shall be allowed to keep terms for Semester III if he/she passes Semester I and Semester II OR if he/she fails in not more than two theory papers of Semester I and Semester II taken together.
 - (c) A candidate shall be allowed to keep terms for Semester IV if he/she passes in each of Semester I, II, III OR if he/she passes Semester I and fails in not more than two theory papers of Semester II and Semester III taken together.
 - (d) A candidate shall be allowed to keep terms for Semester V if he/she passes in each of Semester I, II, III and IV OR if he/she passes Semester I and Semester II and fails in not more that two theory papers of Semester III and Semester IV taken together.
 - (e) A candidate shall be allowed to keep terms for Semester VI if he/she passes in each of Semester I, II, III, IV and V OR if he/she passes Semester I, Semester II and Semester III and fails in not more than two theory papers of Semester IV and Semester V taken together, irrespective of his/her Grade in Project-I of Semester V.
 - (f) A candidate who does not secure a minimum grade of C in project I and or Project II has to submit a fresh project will he/she secures a minimum grade of C.
- vi) The evaluation of project I & II and viva-voce examination shall be by awarding grade in the seven point scale noted below:-

A candidate shall have to obtain Grade C in this seven points scale grade in project evaluation and viva-voce taken together to obtain 50% marks in project work. (vide Circular No. UG/442 of 2001)
