Development and all other fees after cancellation of admission for the Under-Graduate Courses has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 13th June,2008 vide Item No.7.6 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 23rd July, 2008 vide item No.6 and that, in accordance therewith, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 54(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994, it has amended Ordinance 2859 relating to refund of fees to read as under :-

REFUND OF FEES

Refund of Tuition, Development and all other fees after cancellation of admissions:

The candidates who have taken admission in under graduate courses in Govt. colleges, in Govt, aided and unaided courses conducted by affiliated colleges, and recognized Institutions may request for refund of fees after applying in writing for cancellation of their admission to the course. The refund of fees as applicable shall be made on or before 30th day after the date of cancellation and thereafter. The percentage of fee for the course shall be refunded to the candidate after deducting charges as follows:

Further that O.2859-A & O.2859-B have been repealed and the amended O.2859 relating to the refund of Tuition Fees, Development and all other fees after cancellation of admission for the Under Graduate Courses has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2008-2009.
