#### QUALIFYING STANDARD R

Grading by accuracy is important in medical transcription industry. As the examinations will be conducted on real life files; no transcription file goes to proofer /editor/UA with less than 90% accuracy score derived from accumulated error type score from Excel sheet. Pass, Fail criteria or 50% is not applicable here. The examination marks scores will be put in the mark sneet. Our training reduces the effort of employer to train them from scratch. The employer gives a test with file/files, and recruits them based on the score he gets. A student with lower score can be readmitted for a practice course, which will be considered from the reedback of first course, aner
